Lincoln College wants to ensure all conditionally accepted students succeed with their transition to college. To offer assistance prior to the start of the fall semester, Lincoln College *requires* all conditionally admitted students to *attend and fully participate* in The Summer Bridge Program. Summer Bridge is designed to help you succeed at Lincoln College, so failure to attend or participate may impact your fall acceptance status.

Summer Bridge runs the week prior to Orientation and is packed with everything you need for a successful start to your first semester of college. The Summer Bridge Program is offered at no cost to you and will provide you with the opportunity to develop the academic and social skills that you will need in college.

Before you can take advantage of the free Summer Bridge Program, you must complete the following:

- FINANCIAL AID
- Finish the FAFSA, submit all required documents, sign and return your award letter to the Financial Aid Office. *FAFSA Code 001709*
- HEALTH RECORDS
  Submit all required health records and forms to Office of Health Services
- ADMISSIONS

  Submit final high school or college transcripts (if applicable).

  Secure your housing by submitting the \$125 deposit at lincolncollege.edu/deposit.
- MAKE PAYMENT
  Pay your tuition and fees in full or make your first payment on MyLynx.
- ATTEND SOAR

  Attend one of the scheduled Student Orientation, Advisement, and Registration (SOAR) events, no later than July 25, 2020 at Lincoln College by registering at soar.lincolncollege.edu
