DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Program Description

The Entrepreneurship Capstone degree prepares students to read, write, and speak critically in business settings. Students utilize essential knowledge of business principles to develop and/or maintain a small business. They apply an integrated knowledge of small business concepts, functions, and systems to real world situations. Students produce strategic solutions to business problems through the analysis of data in a business environment. They demonstrate an understanding of ethical choices and obligations in a business management setting and evaluate information needed to be responsive to changes in diverse business environments.

Program Requirements

- Requires a previously completed Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree
- Complete a minimum of 120 credit hours
- Minimum of 30 credit hours of upper division coursework (300/400 level)
- Final 30 credit hours completed at Lincoln College
- C or better in all required lower division general education courses and all prerequisites noted below
- Final Lincoln College cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above
