Expressed as a percentage, attrition represents the likelihood that a student will discontinue enrollment whereas retention represents the likelihood that a student will continue enrollment. Combined, attrition and retention equal 100%. The rates reported above were calculated based on all enrolled BBA-seeking students for the Fall, 2018 semester (N = 163), minus graduates from the 2018-19 academic year (graduates = 26, reducing to n = 137), and dividing the number of students who returned Fall, 2018 (n = 92) by the reduced cohort (92 / 137 = 67.15%).	
Graduation rates	A graduation rate expresses the rate at which students achieve completion of their degree program within a given time allotment expressed as a percentage. The rate given above represents the College's six-year graduation rate for BBA-seeking
