## **Indicators Used**

INDICATOR	DESCRIPTION AND HOW IT WAS CALCULATED	
Attrition and retention	Attrition and Retention refer to the College's ability to generate continued enrollment on the part of an admitted student. Expressed as a percentage, attrition represents the likelihood that a student will discontinue enrollment whereas retention represents the likelihood that a student will continue enrollment. Combined, attrition and retention equal 100%. The rates reported above were calculated based on all enrolled BBA-seeking students for the Fall, 2019 semester (N = 186), minus graduates from the 2019-20 academic year (graduates = 35, reducing to n = 151), and dividing the number of students who returned Fall, 2020 (n = 106) by the reduced cohort (106 /151 = 70.19%).	
Graduation rates	A graduation rate expresses the rate at which students achieve completion of their degree program within a given time allotment expressed as a percentage. The rate given above	

represents the College's six-year graduation rate for BBA-seeking
students who entered for the Fall, 2014 academic year $(N = 38)$ .
The number of BBA graduates represented within the Fall, 2014
cohort (n = 18) was then divided by the full BBA-seeking cohort
to yield the six-year graduation rate $(18/38X = 47.3\%)$ .
