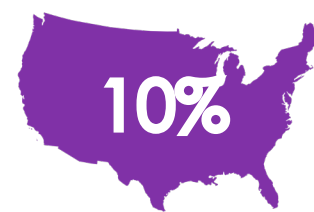

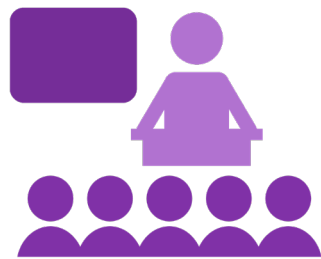

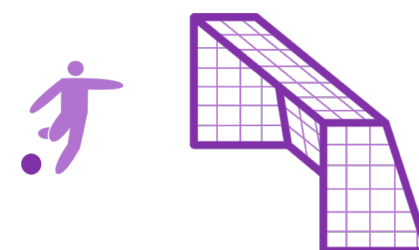

STEP 1:

Complete the free application for admission.

STEP 2:

Submit ACT or SAT test scores and request high school transcripts from your guidance counselor or registrar. Students transferring from another college or university must also submit their college transcripts. Test scores and transcripts should be submitted to the Office of Admissions at 300 Keokuk Street, Lincoln, Illinois 62656.

STEP 3:

Schedule your campus visit by calling 1.800.569.0556 or visiting us online at lincolncollege.edu.

STEP 4:

Complete the FAFSA at fafsa.ed.gov as soon as possible after October 1 of your senior year. We suggest filing before November 1.
