Temporary Accommodations

Lincoln College recognizes that individuals with temporarily disabling impairments resulting from injury, surgery, or short-term medical conditions may need access to services and resources through the Office for Disability Services. Circumstances that may warrant temporary accommodations include, but are not limited to, broken limbs, concussion, hand or arm injury, or short-term complications following surgery or medical treatment.

To receive temporary accommodations, students must submit documentation to the Office for Disability Services detailing the nature, severity, limitations, prognosis, and estimated duration of the disabling condition. Other helpful information could include any adverse side-effects of current medication and recommendations for assistance. This documentation should be recent enough to define current limitations and come from a certified, licensed or otherwise qualified person whose training is commonly accepted for establishing diagnosis.
