General Education Completion Policy:

Lincoln College is an Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI) participant school and honors courses designated under the IAI General Education Core Curriculum (GECC). Students who complete a minimum of 15 credit hours of IAI GECC coursework (through any combination of approved coursework completed at MacMurray College or Lincoln College) shall be allowed to complete general education requirements per IAI GECC guidelines.

Residency Waiver Policy:

Former MacMurray College students choosing to transfer to Lincoln College for degree completion shall not be subject to Lincoln College's regularly enforced residency requirement. Said requirement shall be considered waived.
