- Apply**  
All students should complete the FREE online application.
  
- Submit High School Transcripts and ACT or SAT Score**  
Students should request their high school transcripts and ACT or SAT scores be sent to Lincoln College through their high school guidance counselor. Transcripts can be sent to:

- Visit Campus**  
Students can call **800-569-0556** to set up a personal campus visit or register for an Open House.
  
- File FAFSA**  
Students should complete and submit their FAFSA as soon as possible after October 1 of their senior year (Lincoln College code: 001709). The recommended FAFSA filing date for MAP grant and many LC scholarships is November 1.
  
- Pay Deposits**  
To officially become a Lynx, students can accept their admissions offer by submitting the \$50.00 enrollment and \$125.00 housing deposits as soon as possible. Deposits are refundable until May 1.
  
- Register for Classes**  
Registration/orientation information will be released in early March.
  
- Final Official Documents**  
Students should request their final official high school transcripts and immunization records be sent to the Office of Admissions at Lincoln College.
