Apply

All students should complete the FREE online application.

Submit Official Documentation

If transferring more than 24 credit hours:

- Students should submit their final official high school transcript and official college transcripts from each college or university attended to:

If transferring less than 24 credit hours:

- Students must submit final official high school transcripts, ACT or SAT scores, and official college transcripts from each college or university attended to the Lincoln College Office of Admissions.

File FAFSA

Students should complete and submit their FAFSA as soon as possible after October 1 (Lincoln College code 001709). Recommended FAFSA filing date for MAP grant and many LC scholarships is November 1.

Pay Deposits

To officially become a Lynx, students can accept their admissions offer by submitting the \$50.00 enrollment and \$125.00 housing deposits as soon as possible. Deposits are refundable until May 1.
